One of the world's greatest skicross athletes, Alizée Baron, grew up in Orcières, where she is still a member of the Orcières Merlette 1850 Sports Club. This is where she developed her passion for skiing.

ORCIÈRES, HER PLAYGROUND

Alizée was a downhill skier before she took to skicross. At the age of 11, she took part in France's first junior skicross competition, the Orcières Ski Games, and won! She became hooked on this new discipline. Very quickly, the young skier became a serious competitor at national level.

Between competitions, the skier from Orcières enjoys returning to her heartland to see her friends and fan club. Alizée has her own favourite spots at the resort. She loves skiing down what she calls the playful Camile Ricou slope. And of course she's very fond of the Café Merlettois, where she meets up with her fan club. At the age of just 26, Alizée Baron already has 15 World Cup titles to her name. And she still has plenty of other medals to aim for!

VALENTIN GIRAUD-MOINE, A FIGHTER OF A SKIER

Valentin grew up in Orcières. After earning his stripes in the Champsaur valley, he first appeared in FIS competitions in 2007 before joining the French A-team in 2013. In 2016, he won the French (Elite) downhill championships, an event he had already won in the Hopefuls category in 2012 and 2013.

The 2017 season got off to a good start for the champion from Orcières, who won a World Cup downhill title on the legendary slope of Kitzbühel. But he was stopped in his tracks following a serious fall at Garmisch-Partenkirchen which caused damaged to both of his knees. In need of urgent surgery, he became the first person in France to benefit from a graft to the knee joint.

Valentin Giraud-Moine was skiing again just one year after his injury. With a great deal of self-sacrifice and combativeness, he returned to skiing and again reached world level.

Fully renovated in larch wood brought from the village of Orcières, this chalet of 120 m² offers a modern mountain decor and sleeps up to 10 guests. The ski-theme decoration pays tribute to some great competitors, including the owners' son, Valentin Giraud-Moine, whose shining career continues with his inclusion in the French alpine skiing team. But the skiing theme doesn't stop when you leave the chalet. As soon as you set foot outside, you can reach the ski area by ski.

FARMHOUSE SNACK AND CRAFT BEER At Cabrioles Farm

Noémie and Julien established Cabrioles Farm in 2007. Both trained vets, they came to Orcières to live the mountain life, surrounded by goats.

They have a passion for high-altitude farming and a strong desire to promote the valley's iconic activity among families. The couple share great respect for the region, and attach great importance to the authenticity and quality of their production. In the hamlet of Les Marches, Cabrioles Farm produces not only organic goat's cheese, but also a beer called sOrcière!

They own fifty or so goats and make around ten cheeses from unpasteurised milk, including one named "Marchou" after the local inhabitants. Then there's the Cabrioles brewery. "Water is the basic ingredient required to make good-quality beer. The remarkable water of Orcières contains no nitrates" Julien points out. Some of the hops we need grow on the steep slopes around Les Marches, while the barley comes from the plain and is malted in Ardèche. In lager, amber or seasonal versions, "La sOrcière" is a typical beer made with water from Orcières, following brewing methods traditionally used in the North of France.

The couple also open their gates to families and groups who come to this educational farm for guided and unguided tours, and the chance to hear explanations straight from the farmer's mouth about milking the goats, making the cheese, etc.
