Reducing energy loss in resort buildings

Many of the resort's infrastructures have been renovated in recent years to improve their appearance and to save energy. A major building renovation programme, initiated by a group of condominium managers, was launched in 2014. The goal: To make the resort's residential buildings blend better into the alpine environment through the installation of larch wood cladding on the buildings. Larch locally sourced, high-quality wood whose great advantage is that it does not require treatment. This programme is systematically accompanied by preliminary thermal insulation, in order to reduce energy loss in buildings that are now about fifty years old.

In addition, at the Leisure & Relaxation Complex, the energy produced to cool the ice rink is used to heat the swimming pool. There are many more actions to add to this list, such as the solar panels on the tourist office roof, etc. The new village centre, currently undergoing energy re-qualification, will run on a communal heating network.





The ski area: an articificial snow network that respects the environment

The artificial snow network covering 60 % of the ski area consumes little energy, relying as it does on a gravity-powered circuit rather than one powered by pumping or cooling systems. Its main source of natural water is Lac des Estaris at an altitude of 2,600 m.

Everything is done in accordance with the recommendations of Ecrins National Park. Artificial snow may be unpopular with some people, but it does help guarantee that the ski area can stay open if the natural snow cover is insufficient. Providing 120,000 jobs across all lines of work, it plays an important role in preserving the balance between nature and economic activity. Here, artificial snow is simply water transformed into snow crystals when exposed to low temperatures. The water drawn from the lake goes back to its source at the end of the season when the snow melts.



Green activities: Electric scooter rides

The all-terrain e-scooter is ideal for exploring the snow-covered landscapes of Orcières. Their fat wheels make them easy to handle in any terrain, including snow. Accessible to all aged 12 and over, they're silent, clean and loads of fun. The starting point for guided scooter rides is at the "Ice Racing" ice karting area of the leisure centre. Responsible accommodation Smart recycling of unused beds for a «quality accommodation» label

To remedy the problem of empty beds in the resort, and reduce construction, a renovation policy has been implemented via the Quality Comfort Accommodation label («Qualité Confort Hébergement»). This has yielded gorgeous apartments that meet the demands of current customer bases. The purpose of Orcières Merlette 1850 is to assist property owners with their renovation projects by bringing in professionals (decorators, construction companies, etc.). 150 apartments have already classed as «Orcières Qualité Confort Hébergement» and rated with up to 5 claws (like stars). To be eligible for Orcières' Quality Comfort Accommodation certification, furnished tourist accommodation must first be classed as «Meublés de Tourisme» (furnished accommodation). Among the mandatory criteria, owners must comply with one of the eco-friendly measures to reduce energy or water consumption in the accommodation and take other steps such as sorting waste and using eco-friendly cleaning products.

Built entirely with ecological materials, the Counit offers breathtaking views of the Champsaur valley from its large south-facing terrace. Set in the hamlet of Montcheny, at the gates of the Ecrins National Park, this 6-person cottage is located just 5 min. from the charming village of Prapic, 5 min. from the leisure centre and 10 min. from the resort. Rated 3-star and 3-corn ears, the Counit is also certified Tourisme & Handicap, Famille Plus, and Orcières Qualité Confort Hébergement (4-claw).

Ecrin des Hautes Alpes eco-lodge:

«Winner of the National Coup de Cœur Prize of the Gîtes de France».

Surrounded by nature at the foot of the small resort of Serre-Eyraud, Ecrin des Hautes-Alpes is the very embodiment of a «Gîte de Charme» (Charming Cottage). It's composed of three lodges, proper little gems of 70 to 100 m² that accommodate 2 to 4 people each. Decorated in the old-fashioned way, they have all the charm of tradition while providing every modern comfort for your holidays: Here's the peaceful cocoon you've always dreamt of!

The large-capacity chalet, **«Alpage des Autanes»** opens this winter to welcome families and groups of friends! This former sheepfold has been converted into a traditional chalet. It accommodates 8 people and meets «Écogite» (ecolodge label) standards. Being out in nature doesn't mean you have to sacrifice any comfort. The large, glazed wood stove lends a particular charm to winter evenings, and the gorgeous, well-equipped kitchen promises all kinds of taste sensations! In winter, snow tyres (or chains – socks) are essential.

The Ecogite® Label approach: This is a certification awarded to accommodation of high environmental quality: Preservation of natural resources, minimisation of the negative impacts of tourism on the environment.

Indeed, a major criterion of the «Écogîte» Label is how well accommodation blends into its environment. Seeped in respect for the local architecture and even featuring a chapel at the entrance of the property, the Ecrin des Hautes-Alpes is one of the most classic farms in the Champsaur valley.

Use of renewable energies: Central heating and domestic hot water are provided by a wood-fired boiler. The wood comes from the 5,000m² of woodland adjoining the property. The Nordic bath is also wood fired (stove located inside the bath).

Water and waste management: the taps are fitted with aerators to reduce water flow; natural water is collected to supply the Nordic bath and water the plantations; a shower has been installed rather than a bathtub; there is a rainwater collection system; a composter is available for organic waste; and the list goes on.

"Esprit parc national", the brand of an unspoiled region

The «Esprit Parc National» (National Park Spirit) brand is seal of approval that certifies eco-friendly production and services. Over 250 accommodation providers, traders, artisans, and activity providers come under this ecological label of quality. Delicious mountain and dandelion honeys, organic cheeses from the Cabrioles farm, syrups concocted from aromatic and medicinal plants... These are just some of the products made in Orcières that bear the Esprit Parc National brand. Every Tuesday during the February school holidays, you can sample local products (cheeses, honey, genepi, meats, wild flower and fruit jams, birch sap) brought to you by producers who hold the «Esprit Parc National» label.

At an altitude of 2,300 metres, you'll find a series of whoops, 2 beginners' tables, a box, 2 beginners' jump tables, 1 rainbow rail, 1 flat rail, 1 rope lift and 1 drag lift. 
EXPERIENCES WITH THE RESORT'S PROS:

Backcountry skiing: Follow your guide into the true wilderness of the mountains!

Escape the pistes and hit virgin slopes for fresh tracks in a majestic silence of the mountains... This is the stuff backcountry dreams are made of! Clément Infante, mountain guide, offers freeride / backcountry ski outings in complete safety. He knows Orcières like the back of his hand, down to the most remote corners where he'll take you to find the best snow.

Among the unforgettable backcountry excursions on the massif

There are magnificent outings to be had around the outskirts of the resort, towards snow-covered lakes such as Estaris, a big lake at the heart of a protected natural area, or towards the Freissinières pass and Roc Diolon, the peak that stands guard over the Orcières Merlette resort at the gates of the Ecrins National Park. The descent is amazing, with 1,500 m of elevation drop from the summit, through the Pisses valley down amid the larch trees to Prapic; it even involves crossing streams! Have lunch or make an overnight halt at the Jabiore Inn to prolong this glorious experience! Prapic, one of Orcières' most charming hamlets, is also the start of a whole range of excursions through the Ecrins National Park. These boast magnificent slopes that can be reached on skis, such as Chapeau Rouge, Mourre Froid and l'Homme, among which you can choose the best orientation according to conditions

Biathlon: This year we've got something new to offer you: Archery!

What marks this biathlon out is the archery part! Using a bow and arrow, you shoot at circular archery targets placed at various intervals along the route in a safe manner. It feels like you're Robin Hood on skis... Or Martin Fourcade, France's all-time biathlon hero! After you've grasped some basic technical knowledge of cross-country skiing, you'll need concentration and agility to handle the rifle and shoot. It's an experience like no other!

As part of its efforts to develop Orcières' cross-country skiing potential, the resort is setting up two permanent trails, freely accessible to all.

- > «Méollion» (3.4 km, 640m Elevation gain), duration approximately 1h30, starting from the foot of the slopes at Les Drapeaux (1,850m) and finishing at Pointe de Méollion (2,474m).
- > «Estaris» (4.6 km, 800m Elevation gain) going uphill for 2 hours, starting from the resort (1,870m) and arriving at the top of the Estaris chairlift (2,670m).

To be extra safe, the descent takes you back along one of the ski area's blue runs.
