Orcières, an unspoilt staggering mountain resort in the Southern Alps, renowned for its Mediterranean hospitality!

Orcières is the strength and power of the great Alpine destinations with a touch of the exceptional sunshine and hospitality of the south. Perched at 1,850 m on the edge of the Ecrins National Park, the ski area reaches an altitude of 2,725 m, and provides breathtaking views of the most beautiful 3000-m peaks of the Ecrins: Vieux Chaillol, Pointe des Estaris, Grand Pinier, Petit Pinier and Tête de Dormillouse.

Ideally located between the Mediterranean and the northern Alps (around 2 hours from Marseille and Grenoble), the 100 km of slopes make this one of the biggest ski areas in the Hautes-Alpes, with facilities that are adapted to all levels of ability.

The great diversity of the landscape, with its larch forests, steep granite faces, snow-covered slopes and vast plateaus provide so many playgrounds for enjoying a wide range of outdoor activities, including atypical activities such as dog-sledding, cross-country skiing, snowtubing, snowshoeing, Nordic skiing, snakegliss, ice falls, XXL zip lines, paragliding, nights in igloos, etc. As a leading resort for families since 1962, this destination is ideal for a stress-free holiday (resort with the 'Famille Plus' accreditation) and is also the perfect base camp for sporty visitors, those looking for a festive atmosphere and fans of outdoor activities.

The 22 traditional hamlets which make up the community all showcase the unique terroir and long-lasting traditions such as genepi, tourtons, mountain agriculture, woodworking, breeding and cheesemaking, etc.

The sleeper train leaves Paris at 9pm every Friday night to take fans of the mountains to Gap train station early the next morning, for the luxury of being able to ski on Saturday morning without feeling exhausted! The Orcières Merlette 1850 resort is just 45 min from Gap (7 shuttle services from Gap on Saturdays). The return trip on the Sunday is based on the same principle. Areas just for beginners

There are 4 areas right at the centre of the ski area where beginners can come and discover the joys of skiing with complete peace of mind thanks to the gentle inclines and ski lifts, all designed especially for beginners. The 2 areas right at the foot of the slopes can be reached on foot and the other two are up in the mountains and can be easily reached, one via the Télémix® on Rocherousse plateau and the other one is at the top of the Drouvet 1 chairlift. A great way to enjoy the views while you learn the basics!

2 panoramic outings accessible to all skiers!

You don't need to be a pro to get to the top of the slopes in Orcières and enjoy skiing with a 360° view of the Ecrins mountains. These 8 km and 9 km outings each involve skiing only on easy blue runs and depart from the resort's two highest peaks, then leading you over the ridges, across high-mountain plateaus and then back to the resort, without the stress and with the Ecrins mountains serving as the backdrop.

Outing 1: 6 km route with 800 m difference in altitude, departing from the Drouvet peak at 2,665 m, down the Bouquetins slope and then the Vallons blue run, via Montagnou and then back to the centre of the resort.

The 2nd panoramic outing takes skiers from the peak of Fressinières resort at 2,725 m down 5 blue runs, winding past frozen mountain lakes, across Rocherousse plateau and then down the Bagnols slopes. Skiers can stop off there to recharge their batteries at the Bergerie des Bagnols, a former mountain chalet that has been converted into a restaurant serving local specialities. This 7 km outing with 900 m difference in altitude also ends at the centre of the resort.

SKI LIKE THE PROS!

The FIS-approved 'Camille Ricou' slope, an exceptiona slope for downhill skiing

With a start at an altitude of 2,447 metres and a 2 km descent over a 600 metre difference in altitude covered in an average of 1 minute 20 seconds by the world's best skiers, this magnificent slope is acclaimed as much for its technical qualities as its exceptional snow cover. Good skiers can use it and see what the pros

This winter, the slope will once again host the Women's European Cup from 21 to 25 January 2024.

On Rocherousse plateau at 2,280 m, fans of freestyle skiing will have a ball in this 16,000m² area. There are modules adapted to each level of ability, so beginners, those with an intermediate level and the more experienced can practice or try out the stunts of their dreams! There are several rows of obstacles including boxes, rails and rainbow rails.

Participants will help groom the slopes for the next day. Independent and completely safe cross-country skiing:

With 2 permanent routes, both exercise enthusiasts and recreational skiers will be able to enjoy their hobby at their own pace all day long until the ski area closes

- > « Méollion » (3.4 km, 640 m elevation gain), duration approximately 1hr30 mins, starting from the foot of the slopes at Les Drapeaux (1,850m) and finishing at the Pointe de Méollion (2,474 m).
- > « Estaris » (4.6 km, 800m elevation gain) uphill climb for 2 hours, starting from the resort (1,870m) and arriving at the top of the Estaris chairlift (2,670m). To ensure your safety, the descent takes you back along one of the ski area's blue runs

Exploring unspoilt slopes in a silent and majestic setting is the dream of every cross-country skiing enthusiast! Clément Infante, a high mountain guide, offers freeride / free style cross-country skiing outings in complete safety. He knows Orcières like the back of his hand, down to the most remote corners where he'll take you to find the best snow. Clément offers trips over 2 to 3 days in the heart of the Ecrins park, with nights spent in a refuge or an auberge.

Secret spot! Freeride skiing in the larch forests in Serre-Eyraud

Serre-Eyraud is a haven of fresh-air appreciated by purists who mark their trail through the larch trees in a hushed atmosphere. This unspoilt ski area is a secret spot for skiers who enjoy authentic and freeride skiing. The resort may be small but it can be challenging, with a difference in altitude of 600 m (1,480 - 2,100 m). It is north/north-east facing which means the snow is of great quality. Its two technical slopes are a delight for 'riders', who will also appreciate the numerous off-piste skiing possibilities. Serre-Eyraud is the ultimate experience of nature and authenticity. The resort overlooks the little hamlet with only 20 inhabitants and offers a 360° view over the Champsaur valley. The slopes here follow the natural terrain, with preserved trails and moguls which have not been groomed using machinery. The result is a unique skiing area in the heart of unspoilt natural surroundings! With its 3 ski lifts, the area offers 10 km of slopes for all levels: 2 green runs, 2 blue runs, 3 red runs and 2 black runs. Here, you pick up your pass from the refreshments bar - a pleasant moment for a chat.

Snowshoe excursions 'by the light of the moon' with ESF

These nocturnal snowshoeing outings take place every Tuesday and Wednesday in small groups accompanied by an ESF guide who will reveal the secrets of the mountain world at night. It is not unusual to come across ibexes, foxes and other inhabitants of the mountains. This trip promises to be a unique experience and allows you to explore nature in complete peace and quiet amidst snow-covered larch forests. In the middle of the walk, participants will enjoy a meal served in a typical Champsaur auberge prepared with local ingredients: tourtons, 'oreilles d'ânes' (gratin casserole of wild spinach and either lasagna or crêpes), cheese and charcuterie, etc.

Chamois hikes and ice falls in Prapic

This easy, 2-hour snowshoeing hike departs from Prapic, a little snow-covered historic village in Ecrins National Park with an unspoilt natural environment. Wild animals seek refuge here in winter, far from the crowds. After crossing a larch forest and following the frozen Drac Noir river, walkers reach Charnières plateau and stop to observe their surroundings using binoculars while the expert guide unveils the secrets of the animals that live up at the peaks. Every day, you'll catch a glimpse of chamois, ibexes and marmots! On the way back, you'll be walking past the magnificent Pisse-Bernard ice falls, an unmissable sight of Champsaur Valgaudemar, dubbed the little Himalaya of the southern Alps.

Refreshments at the Ferme des Cabrioles and learn about mountain farming

The Ferme des Cabrioles is a member of the 'Bienvenue à la Ferme' network and is an accredited educational farm where visitors can learn about the farming practices of the mountains. On a visit to the farm, you will be able to meet the animals, discover how the farm operates and learn about the relationship between farming and food. During the visit, children will get the chance to spend time in amongst the goats and see how the milk is transformed into cheese. A visit to the farm and encounter with the animals can also be combined with a cheesemaking workshop where children can then taste their creations. Make sure you wear comfortable shoes for walking.

Artificial snow: gravity-powered network

The artificial snow network covering 60% of the ski area consumes little energy, thanks to a gravity-powered circuit that reduces energy production - in contrast with systems that pump and cool - the main source of natural water being Lac des Estaris at an altitude of 2,600 m.

Everything is done in accordance with the recommendations of Écrins National Park. Artificial snow may be unpopular with some people, but it does help guarantee that the ski area can stay open if the natural snow cover is insufficient. Providing plays an important role in preserving the balance between nature and economic activity. Here, artificial snow is simply waexposed to low temperatures. The water drawn from the lake goes back to its
