ORCIÈRES 60 YEARS OF INNOVATION, AND COUNTING

From the very first sports centre in the heart of a Southern Alps resort (featuring both a swimming pool and an ice rink) to the creation of the Cartable à la Neige school-ski programme, the first-ever Jardin des Neiges for children, the pioneering Télémix® lift, and the imaginative artistic staging of the "World of the Six Lakes" hiking route... Orcières has been innovating for 60 years, acting as a true "locomotive" for the Champsaur territory thanks to the resort of Orcières Merlette 1850.

This is where the resort was born and grew, with local people becoming the first to work thanks to snow and skiing. Many of their children and grandchildren still carry on these mountain trades, shops, and skills today. This is a land to which its people are deeply attached. Hospitality runs deep here — "Here, you feel at home" is a phrase often heard at the Tourist Office.





STRONG, LOCAL VALUES

With roots often in farming, shepherding or even travelling trade, the people of Orcières Merlette 1850 have built their story on knowing the value of effort, the power of novelty and innovation, the warmth of sharing, and the importance of a genuine welcome. Today, Orcières Merlette 1850 continues to evolve with the same ambitions, ready to change its face without ever changing its promise: snow, sunshine, and high-altitude smiles.

This is the DNA of Orcières Merlette 1850 — a destination where families, urban adventurers, and nature-lovers meet in a human-scale setting, enjoying modern facilities and exceptional sunshine.





The desire to take back control of its own future led the municipality to reintegrate ski area operations into SEMILOM management. Since November 2022, the Tourist Office and the ski area have worked hand in hand on a shared 25-year plan, guided by the municipality's strategy and focused on the common good of both visitors and residents.

Tourism habits are changing, guest expectations are rising, and the climate itself is evolving. Orcières Merlette 1850 aims to set an example — in the Champsaur-Valgaudemar, across the Hautes-Alpes, and throughout the French Alps — by building a model that balances tourism economics, protection of its natural surroundings, and the vitality of local life, ensuring employment for residents and the long-term future of public services.



Complete renovation of the Sports & Leisure Centre (Autumn 2025 – December 2026), with energy efficiency upgrades, improved flow management and new facilities: an expanded bowling area, a panoramic spa, a modern gym, and a refurbished aqua play zone.



- Removal of the car park in front of the Tourist Office (scheduled for winter 2027–28) to make way for a 660-space underground facility, freeing up views and creating a 400 m² public plaza for markets, shows, concerts and gatherings.
- **Expansion of the wood-fired heating network**, adding a sixth plant to supply energy to seasonal workers' residences (five are already in service for public buildings).
- Ongoing support for property owners to upgrade their holiday rentals, with over 200 apartments now certified under the "Qualité Confort Hébergement" label, significantly enhancing the seasonal accommodation offer.

ENHANCING THE NATURAL SETTING

Orcières Merlette 1850 is constantly evolving — improving accessibility, increasing pedestrian zones, running free shuttle services — all while enhancing the spectacular scenery at the gateway to the Ecrins National Park.

In places like Rocherousse, the resort disappears from view, leaving you feeling "away from it all"; in the valley, the leisure base offers Nordic skiing trails winding through the forest and along the Drac river. Showcasing this unspoiled nature is a guiding principle, with more contemplative activities helping to foster awareness of environmental preservation.

A perfect example is the summer "World of the Six Lakes" hike: a family-friendly walk enhanced by subtle artistic touches, transforming a simple outing into a heart-touching experience for visitors.

SKI AREA – A MODEL OF INTEGRATION

A mountain playground becoming **EVER MORE ACCESSIBLE**

Orcières Merlette 1850 continues its transformation, offering guests a ski area that is smoother, more comfortable, and firmly rooted in its natural setting. Several major upgrades came into service for winter 2025–26, marking a new chapter in the resort's ongoing evolution.

Rethinking accessibility for beginners

The snowfront underwent a complete makeover in summer 2025 to offer a safer, more user-friendly, and fully dedicated space for beginners. Its slope was softened from 17% to 14%, following tightly controlled works that were subject to environmental impact studies and State approval.

A 170 m covered magic carpet now replaces two outdated drag lifts, serving a beginner zone and a green slope.

The Flocon drag lift was dismantled and relocated to the Lauzières sector, on the western side, to replace an old chairlift and a challenging drag lift.





The Vallons blue run has been reshaped and

widened, creating a more gradual 600 m vertical descent. Beginners can now enjoy skiing blue slopes all the way from the summit of Orcières Merlette 1850 down to the snowfront. This redesign will also improve the flow of skiers, while offering breathtaking views over the Champsaur Valley and the resort itself.

A new 6-seater chairlift (La Muande), departing from the Drapeaux snowfront and arriving between Lauzières and Méollion, has been installed. Its key benefits include:

■ Easier access to the **Camille Ricou piste**, a FIS-homologated red run that is the backbone of Orcières Merlette 1850's sporting ambitions. This emblematic slope hosts the resort's most prestigious annual events, including the Alpine Skiing European Cup speed races, and serves as a training ground for regional clubs and national teams. Improved access via the new chairlift means smoother logistics for competitions — and a better experience for the general public keen to ski it.

- Replacement of three ageing, energy-intensive lifts, offering greater speed and comfort.
- Reduced visual impact on the landscape (fewer pylons).









BLUE FROM TOP TO BOTTOM

BLUE RUNS FROM 2,725 M DOWN TO 1,850 M

In Orcières, skiing goes hand in hand with gentleness for beginners. The resort offers something unique in the Hautes-Alpes: the possibility to descend from the very top of the ski area, at 2,725 m altitude, all the way down to the base at 1,850 m exclusively on blue runs accessible to the widest range of skiers. It's a dream for intermediate skiers seeking both sweeping panoramas and relaxed gradients, and for families eager to share long descents together, each at their own pace.

SKIING WITH 360° VIEWS

The panoramic Bouquetins and Freissinières blue runs start from the ski area's two highest summits (the Drouvet at 2,655 m and Freissinières at 2,725 m), offering a dream route: almost 1,000 m of vertical drop in gentle slopes, punctuated by spectacular views over the Ecrins National Park peaks and the Champsaur Valley.

This winter, the experience is enhanced by the reshaping of the Vallons blue run, making it easier to access the western sector. A development that reflects the resort's ongoing commitment to making high-altitude skiing more accessible than ever.

BEGINNER ZONES

for learning in complete freedom

To make those first turns in complete safety, Orcières offers four dedicated beginner areas, located on the two snowfronts and in the heart of the ski area (mid-station of the Drouvet and the Rocherousse plateau). These secure, easily accessible zones allow both children and adults to discover the joy of sliding in full confidence, before progressing to longer itineraries.

ROCHEROUSSE:

a high-altitude plateau for every kind of winter Fun

At Rocherousse, everything comes together for a perfect winter's day at the top. Perched at 2,300 m, this high-altitude plateau offers a wide array of activities to suit every taste: boardercross for thrill-seekers, cross-country skiing for those craving a sportier glide (new this year: biathlon discovery), snowshoeing or ski touring for soaking in the scenery... and, of course, the magic of a dog sled ride.

After an active morning, it's time for a gourmet break around the outdoor firepits at the mountain restaurant, before heading to the Winterparc for exhilarating runs on giant snow tubes. A true "village square" in the heart of the mountains!

WINTERPARC: the snowtube sensation

Accessible via the Rocherousse Télémix®, and nestled on the plateau of the same name, Winterparc reinvents the way you slide. Here, there are no skis or snowboards—just big inflatable tubes ready to speed down specially groomed tracks. Go solo for pure thrills, or link up to eight tubes together for a laughter-filled group ride. Little ones under four have their own Baby slopes, and thanks to a dedicated lift, there's no need to trek back uphill.

NORDIC AMBIANCE at the leisure center

Just 3 km from the resort, the Orcières leisure center offers a different winter rhythm: that of Nordic skiing. Alongside the Drac River, 40 km of groomed trails invite skiers to glide gently through forests, clearings and breathtaking scenery. Several loops are available, suitable for all ability levels. Visitors come here for a dose of fresh air, to train, or simply to savour the silence of winter, far from the ski lifts.

SERRE-EYRAUD, authenticity at the tip of your skis

In Serre-Eyraud, skiing takes on a whole new dimension. Far from the big ski areas, this tiny resort overlooking a hamlet of just 25 souls offers a timeless interlude. Three lifts, 600 m of vertical drop, 10 km of varied pistes, and above all, a unique off-piste playground where you weave between larches in complete silence. The north-east aspect guarantees quality snow, and the view over the Champoléon valley is the perfect finishing touch for those seeking the mountains in their purest form.

SKI TOURING

in the Écrins with an overnight at the Refuge de l'Oncle Émile

The ESF Orcières ski school offers a two-day ski touring adventure to the preserved hamlet of Dormillouse. Nestled in the Freissinières valley, in the heart of the Écrins National Park, this historic site is only accessible on foot or by skis in winter. After a demanding ascent, enjoy a warm and convivial evening at the refuge, with half-board accommodation, before heading back the next day. Between untouched landscapes, the satisfaction of the climb, and an authentic mountain experience, this outing is aimed at experienced skiers seeking adventure and disconnection.

SNOWSHOEING

on the trail of Chamois in Prapic

Every Friday morning, from 9:15 am to 12 pm, families strap on their snowshoes for a hike from the picturesque village of Prapic into the heart of the Écrins National Park. At first light, the chamois emerge from their hiding spots and can be easily observed through a spotting scope—an unforgettable moment for the youngest participants. The route, accessible to all, winds through snow-covered alpine pastures and larch forests, leading to a spectacular frozen waterfall. On the way back to Prapic, the guide shares more about this curious and playful mountain animal.

SKI TOURING on marked routes

Orcières offers ski touring enthusiasts two marked and maintained routes. Secure and accessible all day, from ski area opening to closing, these trails allow powder lovers to enjoy a peaceful escape with a contemplative effort.

- **Méollion** (3.4 km, +640 m vertical): about 1.5 hrs, starting from the Front de Neige des Drapeaux (1,850 m) and ending at Pointe de Méollion (2,474 m).
- Estaris (4.6 km, +800 m vertical): about 2 hrs, starting from the resort (1,870 m) and ending at the top of the Estaris chairlift (2,670 m). Descent via ski area pistes for greater safety.

The resort launched the Orcières Quality Comfort Accommodation label, rated from 1 to 5 "paws," to encourage the renovation of privately-owned holiday rentals and meet the evolving expectations of guests. Over 200 properties have already been awarded the label, supported by a free coaching service for owners. Beyond comfort and style, the label incorporates eco-friendly criteria, embedding the approach in a sustainable vision for mountain accommodation.

In Orcières, the spirit of conviviality extends naturally to the seasonal workers who help bring the resort to life each winter. Guided by ESF instructors, they progress in a playful setting equipped with conveyor belts, colourful figurines, gentle turns and small bumps. Each session is an adventure in itself: learning to glide, stop, and turn—always through play. At week's end, the medal ceremony is a highlight for children and proud parents alike.
